



# PERFORMANCE FEES

## Spring Musical 2011

Please review the CTC Student/Parent Handbook for policies regarding performance fees. Please be aware that additional out-of-pocket expenses will occur based on the role(s) the student is given for our productions. Also, all students are still required to purchase personal items such as make-up, performance shoes, tights (girls), wigs/hairpieces/moustaches, proper undergarments for quick changes backstage, etc. The performance fees are cost-associated with a student participating in our spring production.

- **Head Shots:** 10-15 poses taken by a professional photographer provided in CD format. Photo session is scheduled for 2010/2011 on Friday, October 15, 2010 at Metro during regularly scheduled rehearsal times.
- **Show T-shirt:** Every student in the cast will receive a show T-shirt for our spring production. Additional T's will be available to purchase for students and family members during the month of January 2011.
- **Make-up Assistant:** Circle Theatre hires a make-up assistant to provide assistance to cast members during dress rehearsals and performances. Students are still responsible for the purchase of their own theatrical make-up and applying make-up prior to arriving at the theatre. In the past, our make-up assistant spends 20-25 hours over 6 days.
- **Hairstylist Assistant:** Circle Theatre hires a professional hairstylist as a consultant to the costumer and to provide assistance to the students during the dress rehearsals and performances. The stylist usually attends 2 to 3 class rehearsals at Metro evaluating students and recommending hairstyles along with any specialty items needed to reach the desired effect. If wigs are used, she will set wigs and help the students apply wigs over wig caps. In the past, our hairstylist spends 6-10 hours prior to our tech week, then an additional 30-35 hours over the 6 days of dress rehearsals and performances.
- **Spring Musical DVD:** Each student will receive a DVD filmed during at least one of our performances.
- **Spring Musical Photos:** Each student will receive a CD/DVD of all photos taken during one of our dress rehearsals and during our photo call.
- **Cast Dinner:** Between our photo call and evening performance on Friday AND our matinee show and evening performance on Saturday, dinner is provided to our cast members and crew.
- **Costume Fees:** Costumes for our spring musical are provided for our students and are paid for through the contributions of our sponsors and ad sales. In years past, additional costume fees have been incurred for extra pieces the director has requested, additional miscellaneous sewing supplies, etc. We have a dedicated team of volunteers who make last minute alterations and mend costumes during our show runs. This fee is to cover the cost of materials only.

**Performance Fee for 2010/2011 ..... \$250.00**

Your performance fee will be assessed to your Circle account and can be broken into 10 equal monthly payments beginning August 1, 2010.
